# What Is Delta's "OWL" AIRCOACH SERVICE?

**It's Regular Airline Operation** — Delta's Aircoach flights are regularly scheduled trips, operated only at night, utilizing planes normally idle until morning. The crews are experienced Delta pilots, copilots, and stewardesses, who fly scheduled daytime flights as well as some Aircoach trips. Dispatching, weather information, radio control and every phase of Aircoach service is standard Delta operational procedure in every respect.

**21 Years Experience** — Delta is one of the nation's oldest *certificated* scheduled airlines, with an enviable record for courteous, efficient and dependable passenger service dating back to 1929. The new Delta Aircoach service is fully approved by the Civil Aeronautics Board.

**Aircoach Planes** used by Delta are standard DC-4 Deltaliners which fly regular daytime schedules at full fares. These are big, four-engined Douglas Skymaster planes with an experience record of millions of hours all over the world. To offer the 40% reduction in fare, Delta operates these ships at night without the frills of daytime service, such as complimentary meals and double stewardess service.

**Seating Arrangement** — To comply with government requirements, Delta has increased the seating capacity of its DC-4's to accommodate 56 passengers, but without altering the essential main cabin pattern of seats in pairs only. Seats for one four-seat family group has been installed aft of the main cabin, and two others forward. Seats are deep-cushioned, have arm rests and ample leg room for a restful, relaxing flight.

**How To Obtain Seats** — Delta Aircoach flights depart from Chicago 10:30 p.m. and from Miami at 12:15 a.m. every night. Decide the date you wish to go; then call at a Delta ticket office or any travel agency. Aircoach seats are reserved only when a ticket is actually purchased. Telephone inquiries are welcome but a ticket must be purchased to reserve a seat. Delta ticket offices and most travel agents require cash payment. If any unforeseen event forces you to change your plans, your tickets must be presented to a Delta ticket office at least four hours prior to scheduled departure time to avoid penalty.

**Baggage** — You are allowed to take 40 lbs. of baggage per ticket, free. Parcels and small bags may be taken into the cabin; suitcases and large packages will be stowed in the hold. Baggage in excess of 40 lbs. will be carried for only 25 cents a pound.

**Transportation To Airport** — Airport limousines or coaches leave Delta offices in Chicago, Miami, and Miami Beach approximately one hour before flight time. Fare is \$1.25 in Chicago and Miami Beach; 85 cents in Miami. The same service is available on arrival.

You may park your own car near the Chicago airport in a large garage, or in an open public parking area. Open parking only is available in Miami.
