The Technician is an important part of the Operations team, and will assist other departments within the Museum as needed.

- Work with the Manager Maintenance to make any necessary repairs to aircraft in the Museum's fleet

- Provide exhibits support to the Archives and Exhibitions staff, particularly as it relates to installation and repair
- Work with the Manager Surplus & Volunteers to set up surplus sales and assist with pick up and unloading of merchandise shipments
- Work with the Director Operations to ensure a safe and clean visitor experience
